As per Met Eireann's red weather alert ([www.weather.ie](http://www.weather.ie)), due to heavy snowfall resulting in hazardous road conditions in certain areas in the East, we wish to advise our patients and families that all outpatient clinics have been cancelled - Thursday, 1st March, 2018 and Friday, 2nd March, 2018.

All appointments will be rescheduled as a priority.

- parent Education Classes are cancelled
